## **BETHEL BAPTIST CHURCH**

## I. History

Bethel Baptist Church was organized on March 31, 1894 with seven charter members. Bethel became affiliated with the Rehoboth Baptist Association on Sep. 7, 1894. For the first 17 years, Bethel was located a few miles north of Shafter in what was known as the Union Building. On June 4, 1910, the church voted to relocate and build a new church where Bethel is now located.

In 1970 an education wing was constructed and a basement added. A new auditorium was built in 1977. A new fellowship hall was constructed in 1985 and expanded in 1996. The old fellowship hall was converted to classrooms. Our present sanctuary was constructed in 2004.

### II. Affiliation
